Dear Parents

Change to School Management Information System (MIS)

As from 7 June 2010, TeAM will be phased out as our MIS, as we move to implement our new system SIMS.net. There are many reasons for this change, including SIMS.net being used as the sole MIS in the Building Schools for the Future (BSF) project in Coventry, as well as allowing easier and clearer access to information for both parents and school staff. SIMS.net is already used by the majority of Coventry schools, and most schools nationally.

The main implication for parents is that TeAM.web will also be phased out over the Summer Term, so from 7 June 2010, you will no longer be able to see your child's attendance, but all other current functionality will still be available. There will be a new 'parental interface' to view attendance and other features, which will be in place by the start of September at the latest, when we will be issuing new log in details for all parents and carers. It is therefore imperative that we have your correct and up to date contact information, including mobile, address, home phone, work phone and e-mail where possible. These details will also be used as part of our move to an improved text communication system.

We trust you will support us with this move to SIMS.net, and are patient as we complete the transfer of information from TeAM and set up the new systems.
