Sample - Code of Conduct

GCSE Drama Residential

As the GCSE Drama Residential is a school trip, the school system for dealing with behaviour will apply. Consequences will therefore be allocated for poor behaviour, attitude to staff or peers and/or application to workshops.

Similarly House Points/Record of Achievement Certificates will be awarded for attitude, commitment and academic contributions in the workshops.

The following behaviour is expressly forbidden and may result in students being sent home/collected at parental expense;

1. Purchase or consumption of any alcohol or drugs
2. Purchase/carrying of weapons or violent conduct
3. Presence in bedrooms other than your own, designated bedroom *at any time*

Students and parents must sign below, agreeing to abide by these rules and the guidelines for behaviour detailed below.

- Mobile phones should be left on 'silent mode' whilst in public areas (museums, theatres, trains/tube, etc) and at night to minimise disturbance/nuisance to others
- Following designated 'bedtime' for students, on return from the Phoenix Theatre, students will maintain an acceptable level of volume to avoid disturbing other residents
- Students will follow instructions from staff, relating to conduct, meeting times/places for their own safety
