



## Cross Curricular at Finham Park

Finham Park School provides student teachers and NQTs with a variety of ICT based training and support. From evening insets to in-class support Finham Park ensures that teachers are provided with the highest quality of ICT related training.

PGCE students on placement at Finham Park receive a six week training programme that includes;

- Two hours of training and support in class
- Additional insets after school
- A 'drop-in' facility to support staff wishing to use ICT within their own curriculum area.

Student teachers on placement undertake a training programme that has been developed by Swanshurst School (<http://www.trainingschool.bham.org.uk/icttraining/>), each week students will develop their own skills in order to teach using a form of ICT in their own subject area by the end of the programme.

No matter what your subject area you will be encouraged by your mentor and peers to use the latest technology in your teaching. Whether it may be a 'one off lesson' or a scheme of work you have developed - staff within Finham Park's Training School will support your success.
