

How will we be supporting our students to settle in?





Settling in...

- Early lunches for first 1/2 term
- Vertical system
- Only Year 7 and 12 in school on first day
- Tour on first day
- On going support from Mentor, Well-being officers, College Leaders, students and staff
- Groupings are very carefully balanced



The Timetable

- Each student will study a 6 period day
- Personal development is ½ an hour and all other lessons are 1 hour long
- We operate a 2 week timetable (10 x ½ hr & 50 x 1 hr periods), so the lessons studied in Week 1 will be different to those studied in Week 2

What is World Class Studies in Year 7?

>An opportunity to study something new

- Lessons designed to complement "normal" lessons
- ➤A chance to experience subject areas which may be offered at GCSE and beyond.
- Lessons planned to enhance learning skills
- ➢All students will study some Mandarin for part of Year 7 unless students have chosen Mandarin as their language. This would replace World Class Studies programme for them.




How will it work next year?

- ➤1 lesson a week of World Class Studies
- ➤3 different Subjects across the year
- Each subject lasts 12 weeks / 1 term
- ➢You choose 2 subjects your child would like to study from the 5 subjects being offered.
- ➢You choose 2 reserve choices with your child, in case first choices are unavailable
