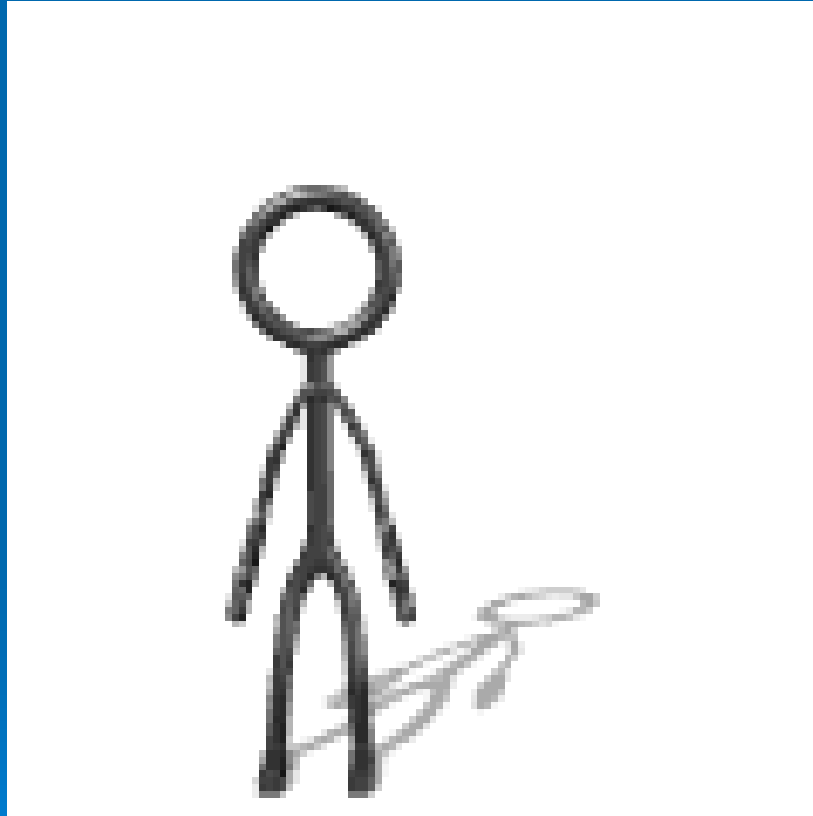


YEAR 12 PROGRESSION EXAMS SUMMER TERM 2025



WHAT'S THE POINT OF THE PROGRESSION EXAMS?

- They show progress made and help teachers make judgments on where to target their teaching
- They may affect your choices in Year 13
- If you miss exams in the summer (eg ill-health), exam boards may use the results of practice exams to award a grade.
- They give you a chance to perform under realistic examination conditions and help to prepare you for the summer exams in Year 13
- They may provide evidence for teachers to use to produce Centre Assessed Grades

DURING THE EXAMS

Written examinations

With effect from 1 September 2024


This document has been written to help you.
Read it carefully and follow the instructions.

If there is anything you do not understand, especially which calculator you may use, ask your teacher.

A. Regulations – Make sure you understand the rules

- 1 Be on time for all your exams. If you are late, your work might not be accepted.
 - 2 **Do not** become involved in any unfair or dishonest practice during the exam.
 - 3 If you try to cheat, or break the rules in any way, you could be disqualified from all your exams.
 - 4 You **must not** take into the exam room:
 - (a) notes;
 - (b) AirPods, Earphones/Earbuds, an iPod, a mobile phone, a MP3/4 player or similar device, a watch, smart glasses or any other smart device.
- Any pencil cases taken into the exam room **must** be see-through.
- Remember: possession of unauthorised material is breaking the rules, even if you do not intend to use it, and you will be subject to penalty and possible disqualification.**
- 5 If you have a watch, the invigilator will ask you to hand it to them.
 - 6 **Do not** use correcting pens, fluid or tape, erasable pens, highlighters or gel pens in your answers.
 - 7 **Do not** talk to or try to communicate with, or disturb other candidates once you have entered the exam room.
 - 8 You **must not** write inappropriate, obscene or offensive material.
 - 9 If you leave the exam room unaccompanied by an invigilator before the exam has finished, you **will not** be allowed to return.
 - 10 **Do not** borrow anything from another candidate during the exam.
