Our schools are committed both to working together to increase opportunity and choice for the Post 16 learner and to deliver “World Class” teaching and learning in our Sixth Forms. It will provide all types of students with an opportunity to follow a programme of study across any of our schools that will enable them to have the time of their lives, be successful and achieve a positive destination for their future.

1. Careers support

You will receive personalised support for your chosen career pathway through mentor time which will be supported by external experts. Regular visits from apprenticeship providers, universities and employers enable you to have a wide range of experiences to make an informed decision on your next steps. Our partnerships with the Chamber of Commerce, local companies such as Jaguar Land Rover, Severn Trent and the University of Warwick will support you in determining the next stage of your journey.

Your future is important to us, and we are here to support you as part of the 'Finham Park Multi Academy Trust Sixth Form'. We have a highly experienced and dedicated team who provide specialist support for you. This includes our Heads of Sixth Form who are supported by Deputy Heads of Sixth Form, Sixth Form Tutors and mentors, Careers Advisors, academic and wellbeing mentors as well as our SEND and Inclusion teams. You will receive one to one sessions to explore your interests and career ambitions.

In addition, you will benefit from employability sessions and support in writing CVs, applications for university and applications for apprenticeships and employment. Our careers and higher education programme provides workshops from universities, one to one support as well as group visits. You will also take part in a week of work experience in Year 12.

2. Period 6+ talks



When the school day ends, learning does not stop. Life in Sixth Form is about so much more than just attending lessons. We therefore give access to a range of opportunities to enhance your Sixth Form experience.

You will have access to external speakers; visits; enrichment clubs; as well as a personal development programme which will prepare you for further education or employment at the end of your Sixth Form studies. Examples this year have included working with the local Police team for a series of self-defence lessons, speakers from the security services, genocide survivors, environmental speakers, careers in the NHS, how to apply to Oxbridge workshops, real Dragons Den opportunities, employability sessions and workshops ran by universities.



3. Trips and visits

You will have access to a wide selection of educational visits including those that enrich your curriculum and community to reward activities for yourself. Examples of past educational visit experiences include those directly linked to your courses, such as field work, subject specific conferences or theatre visits. Previous educational visits have included touring the CERN Large Hadron Collider in Geneva and United Nations, participation in a Ugandan global conference, UCAS discovery days, various theme park visits, Duke of Edinburgh Gold level expeditions, New York and Paris art gallery tours and an Austria ski trip.

Visits to Careers Fayres are offered to all our sixth form students, alongside talks from local and national employers. You can expect to visit universities where you will tour the grounds, have taster seminar sessions and learn about university life. Universities will also visit our sixth forms to enhance your experience and further inform your future choices.

4. Shared work experiences

We enjoy and benefit from a large database of contacts for work experiences that students can access. You will take part in week-long work experience to support a chosen career path in year 12. Our Sixth Form leadership teams and our Careers Advisors support students in accessing work experience tailored to the interests and needs of each individual student.



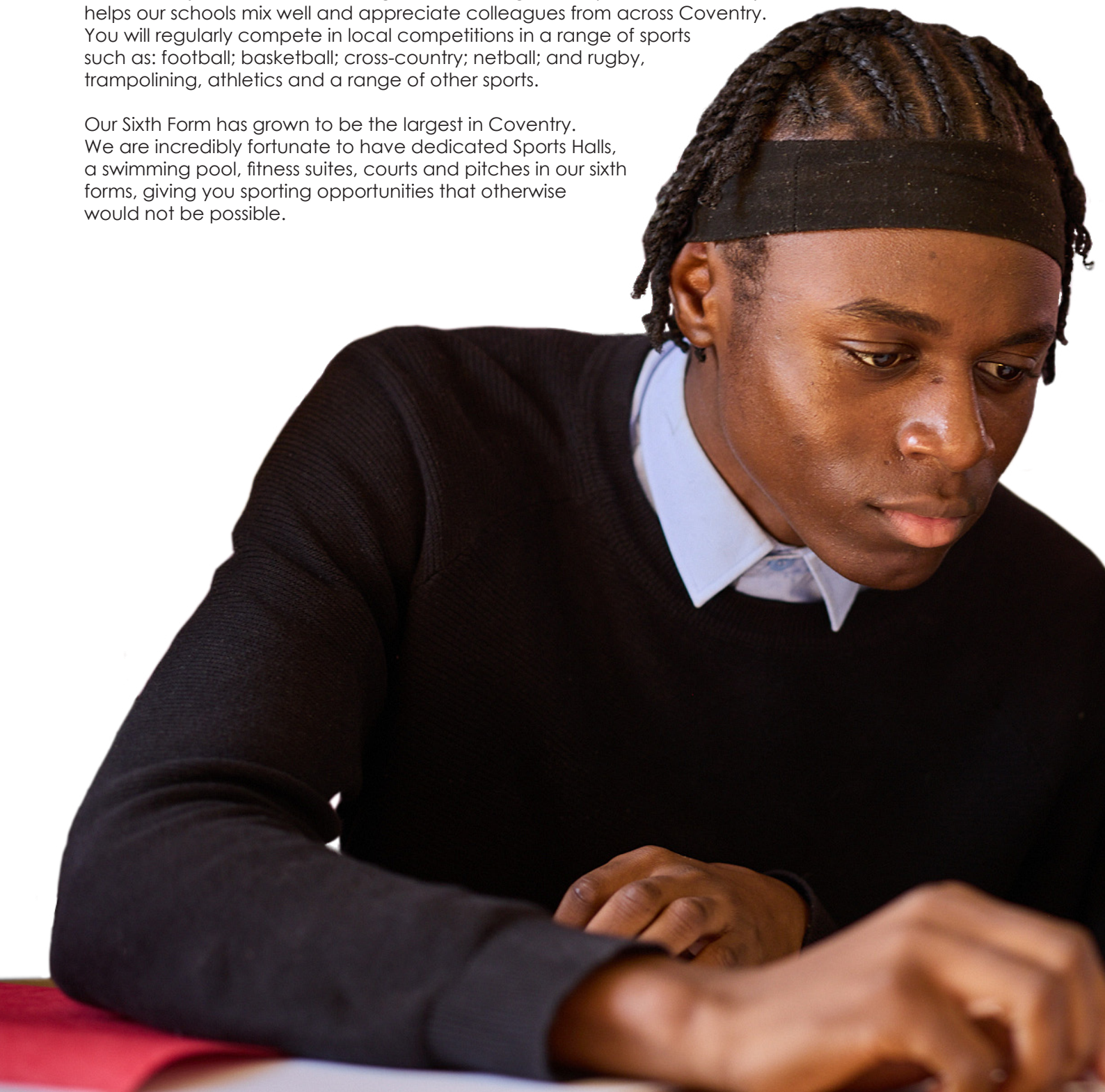
5. Sporting fixtures

Fantastic Sports facilities are available for all students to access both during the day and after school across our schools.

Students who have elite sporting commitments can continue this as part of the enrichment programme. Various opportunities are provided for schools within the MAT to compete centrally, both competitively and collaboratively.

Students enjoy sports and keeping fit. Competing for fun (and the trophies!) helps our schools mix well and appreciate colleagues from across Coventry. You will regularly compete in local competitions in a range of sports such as: football; basketball; cross-country; netball; and rugby, trampolining, athletics and a range of other sports.

Our Sixth Form has grown to be the largest in Coventry. We are incredibly fortunate to have dedicated Sports Halls, a swimming pool, fitness suites, courts and pitches in our sixth forms, giving you sporting opportunities that otherwise would not be possible.





6. Equality, diversity and inclusivity

We are proud to be an inclusive, warm and welcoming Sixth Form Partnership. We have been described by others as caring and compassionate where teachers know their pupils well and tailor the wider curriculum to students needs and experiences.

Our schools have won various nationally and internationally recognised awards that celebrate our commitment to EDI with one company remarking that there is 'inherent joy in all that we do'. Awards have included 'Internal Schools Award' from the British Council, Word Class Schools, Inclusion Quality Mark Centre of Excellence, Sports Mark Gold award, International Cross of Nails School and inaugural member of the UNESCO Associated Schools Network.

With a thoughtfully designed curriculum that is ambitious and tailored to the interests of all our pupils, there are many opportunities to discuss wider issues, such as your worldview, careers, health or your wellbeing. You will be taught how you can contribute positively to society and will be asked to provide training for staff and colleagues about how to live in a diverse community. As a result, you will have good relationships with staff and will be committed to your studies. You will have a personal development programme which is underpinned with first class careers advice to enable you to leave our schools pursuing further education, employment or training.





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
